- 1. Suggestions from Members of the Public
  - 1.1 There were no suggestions from members of the public.
- 2. Minutes of the Meeting 19<sup>th</sup> April 2017
  - 2.1 Minutes of previous meeting on 19<sup>th</sup> April 2017 were approved and signed by the Chairman.
- 3. <u>Matters arising from the previous minutes</u>
  - 3.1 Playing Field: Cllr. Hare has contacted Outdoor Play People regarding the repairs and they anticipate carrying out this work next month.
  - 3.2 Henver Lane: it was agreed the Parish Council is unable to carry out any road widening or creation of a footpath along this stretch of road.
- 4. <u>Police Matters</u>
  - 4.1 Police report 1<sup>st</sup> 31<sup>st</sup> March: Police have been called to the Parish three times; two of these were road related. 1 crime was recorded under the Malicious Communications Act.
  - 4.2 Police report 1<sup>st</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> April : Police received one call to the Parish which was road related. No crime was recorded.

#### 5. Cornwall Council Matters

- 5.1 As re-elected Councillor for the Ladock, St Clement and St Erme Division, Cllr. Eathorne-Gibbons thanked everyone who had supported him.
- 5.2 Following the elections Cornwall Council is forming a new administration of which he will have further details at next month's meeting.

### 6. Planning

- 6.1 Cllrs. Hicks declared an interest in item 6.3 and took no part in the discussion or decision making.
- 6.2 PA17/02408 Application for variation of condition number 4 at Nancarrow Farm extension of completion time from 17.00hrs to 19.00hrs for educational visits: this was discussed and a vote taken. 4 in favour; 3 against; Approved.
- 6.3 PA17/03543 Application for erection of a steel portal frame cattle building at Zelah Lane Farm it was proposed by Cllr. McCulloch, seconded by Cllr. Hare that it should be approved carried unanimously.
- 6.4 PA17/03451 Application for conversion of barn to provide residential dwelling on Glebe land at St Allen the Parish Council agrees in principle with the conversion but recommends that it is carried out in a more sympathetic manner, i.e. stone clad instead of a timber finish and a traditional chimney rather than a steel pipe. It was noted also that there is an existing right of access over the land which would need addressing.

## 7. <u>Update on A30 improvements – Carland to Chiverton Cross</u>

7.1 Nothing to report owing to the election period. The final route is not likely to be known until the end of July.

## 8. <u>Village Improvements</u>

8.1 Any future plans are currently on hold pending the A30 outcome and our new Street Cleaning contract (to start 1<sup>st</sup> June).

## 9. <u>Street Cleaning Tender</u>

- 9.1 Two quotes have been received:
  - (i) Team Maintenance Services @ £5940 inc VAT per annum for the first year, then rising in line with the Retail Price Index in years 2 & 3;
  - (ii) Phoenix Services @ £6204 inc VAT per annum. It was agreed to offer the contract to TMS. Proposed: Cllr. Hare; Seconded: Cllr. Orrell. All in favour.

#### 10. <u>Correspondence</u>

10.1 Jon Rowell (Countryside Access Records Officer) has replied to our letter requesting more information on the proposal to upgrade the Cost-Is-Lost footpath to a Restricted Byway. Evidence supplied to him by the applicants suggests that a right of way might exist and therefore Cornwall Council is legally obliged to upgrade the path. This was noted.
