ST ALLEN PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 20th January 2025, 7PM AT ST. ALLEN PARISH CHURCH

2 Members of the Public

1. Chairman's Announcements:

1.1 As both the Chair and Vice-Chair were absent it was proposed by RH and seconded by AS that JM Chair the meeting. This was unanimously resolved.

2. A30 Carland Cross to Chiverton:

- 2.1 Dave James (Costain) gave the following update:
 - There have been no real changes following the update given before Christmas and the works are scheduled to finish at the end of May 2025, although landscaping will continue after this date.
 - Henver Lane to Boxheater is scheduled to reopen in mid-February. Work here includes resurfacing, drainage and kerbing. This work has to be completed before Boxheater to Carland Cross can be shut.
 - Chybucca to Henver Land is scheduled to reopen at the end of February
 - Carland Cross to Boxheater will be closed in March to build the multispecies crossing. This will then re-open for Easter before being closed again for a further 4 weeks but under traffic light control.
 - The old A30 under Marazion Green Bridge is now open for buses and local residents.
 - Trevalso is scheduled to open later than scheduled as there is more work than anticipated resulting in a change to the program.
 - Boarded fencing has been installed between Zelah Hill and Tolgroggan, similar to that at Chybucca Bridge to prevent light pollution
 - The earth bank between old A30 and Henver Lane will be reinstated and planted with trees.
 - DJ will check when the junction and roundabout works at Carland Cross will be completed.
 - Pennycomequick will not open until early May. While Boxheater to Carland is shut the diversion route will be via the Mitchell A30 junction.
 - While Boxheater to Carland is shut, if you are travelling to Perranporth on the A30 the likelihood is that you will be diverted via Chiverton Cross.
 - One lane is currently shut on the A30 at Carland Cross for telecommunication works.
 - The February PC meeting will be held at the Costain Depot, Carland Cross. From March, meetings will return to the Church.

- 4. Minutes

4.1 RESOLVED: The minutes of the meeting held on 16th December 2024, as circulated, were approved, and signed by the Chairman. (P/S: JM/AS)

5. Matters Arising from the Minutes:

- 5.1 RH has 'tidied up' the wall in the Playing Field where the cut through was created. Thanks were expressed to RH for doing this work.
- 5.2 Cornwall Council will not install an 'unsuitable for HGV' sign at the start of the road from the village to Cost-Is-Lost, mainly due to budgets. It was discussed that the PC could purchase their own sign direct from the supplier to install.

 RESOLVED: Clerk to investigate costs so that a decision can be made at the next meeting.
- 5.3 The Clerk had reported the uncapped mineshaft near Cotton Springs to Perranzabuloe Parish Council.

6. Police Matters:

6.1 No report. JO will attend the Police Liaison Meeting on 5th February.

7. Cornwall Councillor Report:

- 7.1 Cllr. Harvey advised that the Council will tomorrow vote on a motion ruling out talks to merge with Devon Council.
- 7.2 Cllr. Harvey attended a briefing about the future of Newquay Airport. The information provided was unsatisfactory and raises more questions than answers.
- 7.3 A protest was recently held at Watergate Bay regarding the Council's proposal to transfer 25 car parks to a private operator. The Clerk advised that she had sent an objection, as had the CAP group. The consultation only closed on 13th January so there is no further update.

8. CAP Report:

8.1 The CAP had agreed to send a collective objection to the Off-Street Parking Order 2025, see 7.3.
